

FEBRUARY 2024 NORTH CAROLINA BAR EXAMINATION REQUIREMENTS

All applicants must comply with the following requirements for the February 2024 North Carolina Bar Examination:

- I. Applicants are not permitted to handwrite the Multistate Essay Examination (MEE) and Multistate Performance Test (MPT) components of the North Carolina Bar Examination. Unless granted a testing accommodation due to a disability under the Americans with Disabilities Act, applicants must take the MPT and MEE portions of the examination using their personal laptop computers and ExamSoft Examplify® secure software.

Laptop registration for the February 2024 North Carolina Bar Examination will begin at 12:00 p.m. Eastern Time on December 12, 2023, and end at 5:00 p.m. Eastern Time on January 5, 2024.

Applicants must pay the \$125 administrative fee and complete the laptop registration process by 5:00 p.m. Eastern Time on January 5, 2024. Please note that the laptop fee is non-refundable and non-transferable.

Detailed information on how to register will be available at www.examsoft.com/ncbar. Prior to registration opening, ExamSoft will email all applicants an ID and password to download and install Examplify®. The registration information will come from noreply@examsoft.com. Applicants should add this email address to their contact list to prevent these important emails from going to their spam or junk folder.

Applicants should mail the registration payment to the North Carolina Board of Law Examiners with the Laptop Application. The laptop application can be found in the 'Laptop Use' section on the home page of the Board's website, www.ncble.org.

Registration needs to be completed and payment needs to be received no later than 5:00 p.m. on January 5, 2024. This is a receipt deadline, not a postmark deadline.

Applicants who do not comply with the requirements listed in this section will NOT BE PERMITTED TO SIT for the February 2024 North Carolina Bar Examination.

- Incomplete Application Declaration (if applicable)

Applicants are required to complete and upload these forms to their secure portals on or before 5:00 p.m. on February 7, 2024.
