Passing Score Reduced for July 2020 and February 2021 North Carolina Bar Examinations

Recognizing the unique and extraordinary circumstances involved with the COVID-19 pandemic, the North Carolina Board of Law Examiners has made the following changes to the passing score for the July 2020 and February 2021 North Carolina bar examinations:

- (1) the minimum passing score for the July 2020 and February 2021 North Carolina Bar Examinations will be reduced from 270 to 268;
- (2) the minimum acceptable score for UBE Transfer applicants who sit for the UBE in July 2020, September 2020 or February 2021 shall be reduced from 270 to 268; and
- (3) that the minimum passing score will return to 270 for the North Carolina Bar Examination in July 2021.
